Immortal Soulhunters Guild Rush Mission Guide

Greetings Soulhunters,

Guild Rush is the third mission available for Immortal Soulhunters. Rush is a 30 min race while transformed to an animal specific to the zone. There are seven (7) race courses (see below). To successfully complete Rush, 15 people need to cross the finish (transformed) line in the 30 minute window. Anyone crossing the finish line in the 30 minute window will receive a weekly reward of 1 Guild Commendation, 2 rares, and 50 silver. There is an additional chest at the end of the race that contains standard chest loot.

- Bear Lope
- Chicken Run
- Crab Scuttle
- Devourer Burrow
- Ghost Wolf Run
- Quaggan paddle
- Spider Scurry

Please review the routes before the race. The courses can contain traps jumps and other nastiness designed to prevent you from completing. You must pass through the flags along the course to receive credit. While transformed you will have several spells specific to running the assigned race. Spell (1) will locate traps and should be used whenever it is available.

We will rally at the starting point. DO NOT ACTIVATE THE RUSH, an assigned officer will activate when we are ALL ready. Once all participating members have arrived and specific instructions are passed out the Rush will be activated. For the benefit of all players Soulhunters will split into multiple groups (escorts, support and runners). Support groups will station themselves along the course to assist the runners with buffs (speed/stability...) and protection from local creatures. Escorts will run the course non-transformed to support and protect the runners. Runners will fly like the wind to the finish line Once the running group completes the course the groups will switch function until all participating members have completed the race.

The group transition will be:

Runners will move to Support Support will move to Escort Escort will move to Runners
